And Whereas:	Allowing more students to run for executive positions could help improve the lack of competition in recent executive elections,
BIRT:	 Bylaw 2: Elections and Referenda, Chapter III, Section B, Article 3.a.ii be amended to read: ii. For two Members to be eligible to run as a candidate pair: 1. Both At least one Members, according to their academic program scheduling, will not be an On-Term Members of the Society for both of the next two Academic Terms of that Society or will be on academic exchange for one of the next two terms of that Society. 2. Each of the Members, according to their academic program scheduling, will be On-Term Members of the Society for at least one of the next two Academic Terms of that Society. 3. Both Members intend to be full time, registered undergraduate engineering students at the University or at a partner school of the University for the following four Academic Terms; and 4. Each Member in a Pair Candidate will serve 8 months of the 16 month term.
