4 Guest Speaker

4.1 CECA - Stephanie Tortici (cecamc4@uwaterloo.ca)

- Responsible for student engagement
- Demo of search and apply on waterloo works
- Write down feedback and it will be collected
- WaterlooWorks = Jobmine replacement, also to be used for appointments, with CECA, etc.

- Q: Has there been any feedback from ARCH students?
 A: They aren't using it yet.
- Student benefits:
 - distinguish between items seen and items not
 - omit certain items from searches
 - searches can be saved
 - Google Maps of job now so you can see location
- Q: Is it mobile friendly? A: Yes.
- Q: Will there still be a short list?
 A: Yes.
- One free "Not Ranked" to give to jobs you don't want to take for any reason.
- Code of conduct: Formalized and to be accepted ever term now.
- Employers can include salary in job postings now.
- Employers can also provide more information for why or why not a student was ranked or not ranked.
- Q: Is salary posting mandatory or optional?
 A: Optional.
- Q: How will employers be held accounable for salaries posted?
 A: They can't really.
- Job application limit not decided on at present time.
- Uses CAS to login
- Some default quick searches
 - For my Program
 - Applied to
 - Short list
 - Not-interested list
 - Saved search criteria
 - etc
- Q: Can you search for jobs outside of your program?
 A: Yes, there is an advanced search function that can be used for that.

- "Save Search Criteria" option
- Q: For advanced search can you only select one cluster?
 A: No, you can select multiple using "control".
- Employers select criteria they want, eg., Cover letter, transcript, and not able to apply without the documents.
- Q: So will cover letters and resumes be separate documents now?
 A: Yes, now they will be separate.
- Clarification: Can upload as many documents as you want, eg. Cover-letter-1.pdf, cover-letter-job7.pdf, Resume-technical.pdf.
- Can group documents together or select them individually for the application.
- File types only PDF.
- Google maps will be able to give directions on WaterlooWorks.
- Q: Will you be able to guarantee that the address is the job location not the head office?

A: When employers get the job approved, they will have to provide all that information to us beforehand.

- Final Questions/comments:
 - Q: Will there be a mobile app coming out?
 A: No but it is mobile compatible.
 - Q: Will you be hiring someone to make an app?
 A: No, since it's purchased, but maybe Orbis will.
 - Jan. 2015 there will be no more jobmine?
 - Q: Do you predict any problem with the transition?
 A: We have risk management and plans for this, but it should be smooth.
 - Q: Will there be a timeout feature on WaterlooWorks?
 A: I don't think so, it hasn't timed me out yet.
- There will probably be a Facebook group or website for feedback, there is currently a sharepoint.

5 Executive Report

5.1 President - Allyson Francis (president.b@engsoc.uwaterloo.ca)

- No decisions at this meeting, all many to be done at joint council.
- Quick runthrough of JC agenda:
 - Dean to come speak, mostly about E7
 - Decision on whether or not to have referendum if students would like to donate student money (one million) to new building.
 - "Are you in favour of donating \$1 000 000 of student money through \$25 termly optional payments from students?"
 - Payments would only get charged when building opens.
 - Comment: Since the building will take time, most of us won't be around to pay for it once it's open anyway.
 - Dean is hoping to break ground next year.
 - Q: If we vote no, do we still get student space?
 A: Yes, since we're not buying the study space, but we probably wouldn't get naming rights.
 - Voting on whether or not we want to adopt new EngSoc Documents.
 - Will need to create a new board of directors if we accept the new documents, election will be held right away.
 - Board of directors would manage EngSoc at an overhead level, rather than a day-to-day level as exec does.
 - Fee increase goes up every joint coucil, only be inflation, 25 cents this term.
 - Creating a teaching award from EngSoc to Professors. We'd give them a plaque and create packages to help nominate them for other awards. A committee wouldn't be voted for until winter.
 - More generic governance decisions to be made.
 - Executive Review committee will be created in response to A-soc's motion to create VP-Communications last term.
 - Updates from both exec, affiliates, announcements for large events that would interest A- and B-soc.

- Leadership excellence award applications still open until Sunday, requirements are online.
- Pres is sitting on Committee to discuss fall reading week, what the consequences for students would be if we had a Fall Reading Week.

- Students are getting involved in training the incoming students, faculty are pleased about this.
