- CECA has been working towards lowering the number of unpaid jobs on jobmine by convincing companies to pay minimum wage at least or relocation costs.
- Reduced unpaid jobs from 8% to 2%.
- Work term reports are currently purely technical in engineering, but many people feel work term reports should be the same across all faculties, which would make engineering work reports more reflective.
- Comments from students:
 - Making the report more reflective would be beneficial to students such as nano who don't necessarily have projects that can be written on in depth.
 - In the past I've had a job that didn't have engineering qualities or projects, and it made the report more difficult and dishonest.
 - I know other people with reflective reports, and they still don't enjoy them, but they seem more useless than technical reports.
 - Q: Are we going to be getting rid of them or are they for accreditation?
 A: Another option would be something similar to the University of Guelph,

- where students fill out similar forms to what they have to do for the PEO anyway, and do technical reports for labs.
- Technical reports can be hard to come up with if you don't have an engineering project oriented position, but they are still helpful
