#### **6.0 Executive Reports**

## 6.1 President – David Birnbaum (president.a@engsoc.uwaterloo.ca)

- Survey regarding Sunday exams.
- Most students do not seem to be in favor of Sunday exams.
- Can see minutes and recommendations of FEDs councillors for other suggestions that they made.
- Sustainability on campus was discussed.
- FEDs general meeting has been set, proxies can be set online
- Feds.ca for more information on all this
- FEDs saying that students want a fall reading break
- Pushing for a third engineering councillor, going forward slowly, eventually there will be a new full time councillor

- Undergrad office will be moving to E2
- Exam bank: Exams directly from professors to EngSoc. Guidelines are being written now
- Syllabus bank: Gathering interest, but not as much faculty in favor of the syllabus bank, but possibly students to run it anyway
- Q: Reason for not wanting syllabus bank?
  A: Professors are hesitant because they don't want the syllabi to clash within different sections or offerings of the same course, students might look at the syllabus of one course and get something else.
- Q: Is that a concern as classes are already different? A: Maybe.
- Q: Many upper years just want to know the grading system for the course before upper years sign up for it, if not a full syllabus could students get that?
  - A: Possibly. Will talk to faculty
- Point: Professors also might have different grading schemes for the courses which would make that less useful.
- Future exec might move forward with it anyway.
- ELPE: Math has gotten rid of the ELPE, engineering should be getting rid of it within two years. To be replaced with some other sort of diagnostic, as well as possibly adding English course requirements for students.
- Students who have already written the ELPE won't have to worry about it.
- ELPE doesn't necessarily give enough of a test to see if
- Q: Could it be added to a PD course?
  - A: Potentially
- Q: Factoring it in to the CSE requirements
  - A: That's a possibility as well.
- Point: Would be beneficial to add an English course, engineers suck at English.
- Q: Could TAs and people marking our assignments also speak English? A: This has been brought up as a point before.
- Final point: In other faculties, if you get less than a 32 on a course, it counts as a 32 when calculating the average. This is not the case in engineering, but in the future it should be. It will still show up as less than 32 on the transcript, but would affect those who might have failed and been required to withdraw or repeat a term. On average 4 students per term in engineering would be affected.
- Q: Where does the 32 come from?
   A: 32 is also used in other cases, such as DNW (Did not write) final exams.
- Q: What benefit is there in promoting students that don't understand the course material?
  - A: They will still need to repeat the course, but if it is the only one they fail it shouldn't make them fail the course.
