Guest Speaker

Course Critiques - Gordon Stubley

- Changes to be made to course evaluations. Uniform questionnaire across faculties and undergraduate/graduate courses.
- Representatives from each faculty and experts from other groups
- group has been meeting for year and a half
- Final report: Expect we will be running course evaluations online with software program called Evaluate. Has already been in use by math and science.
- The questionnaire is going to change to be uniform across campus, probably in the start of 2017. Two step process.

- Engineering was unique in working together with students and faculties, other faculties did not have as much collaboration. Some of this is hard to replicate by other faculties
- The literature tells us that questionnaires are very context dependent, so results depend a lot on different cases.
- Will be looking for student volunteers for a focus group to fill out questionnaires and find out how well they measure the courses.
- Q: We will be moving towards online system? A: Correct, we will be. A few of you may see this as early as the fall, or in the winter.
- Q: Has a process been added to include a course critique director to evaluate comments and pull offensive comments?
 A: There is a plan to do screening this fall which is the same as always, we envision that it will be more efficient to do this online in the future.
- Student body self-censors with regards to inappropriate comments. If something inappropriate is present, the whole review is removed and the opinion is not heard.
- Should written comments be seen by the Deans and Chairs, or just by the Professors, as the Professors are not able to offer a defense to.
- Q: Currently the professors take 15 minutes from class to do evals and leave the room. We get response rates in line with the attendance rates. Will there be something similar now for the online option? What will happen to response rates?

A: People have been running course evals online for some time now, and there are best practices. The professors should give the same 15 minutes during class to fill out evaluations, and get the same turnout results as with paper evals. Since they are also online, we will also be able to leave them open online for longer so that students are able to fill them out if they happen to miss the class.

- Q: How many emails will I get telling me to do this? A: The emails will be tailored, so once you have filled out your evaluation, you won't get anymore.
- The group behind the student portal will be consulted for the communication.
- Q: Is it mobile friendly? A: Yes.
